





Founded in 1994, **Camp Courage** creates an unforgettable recreational experience for children and teens with cancer or blood disorders from the Upstate of South Carolina, western North Carolina, and Northeast Georgia. Campers are free to play, laugh, explore, and grow in a normal developmentally appropriate way. 24 hour medical supervision is provided while children are at camp.

Carolina Shag Club has provided monetary support to **Camp Courage** for an estimated 20 years. Each year, CSC invites **Camp Courage** caregivers and staffers to the annual Christmas Party where they are presented with the CSC's funds raised over the past year.

The **Ellen Taylor Foundation for Junior Shaggers** ("ETFJS") was founded in 2007 by Mrs. Ellen Taylor and incorporated as a SC 501-3(c) organization in 2008. **The Foundation** is a non-profit charitable foundation dedicated to financial assistance in the education, preservation, and promotion of the Shag, the state dance of South Carolina. The purpose of the **ETFJS** is to remove financial barriers that prevent those under 21 from learning and participating in the shag dance. Examples of this include providing free dance shoes, funding workshops, and providing meal, lodging, and gas vouchers for shag dance events

Each summer, the **Ellen Taylor Foundation** hosts a Junior SOS (typically in July) in support of the junior shaggers. Carolina Shag Club has provided monetary and logistical support for **Junior Shaggers** for approximately five years.


