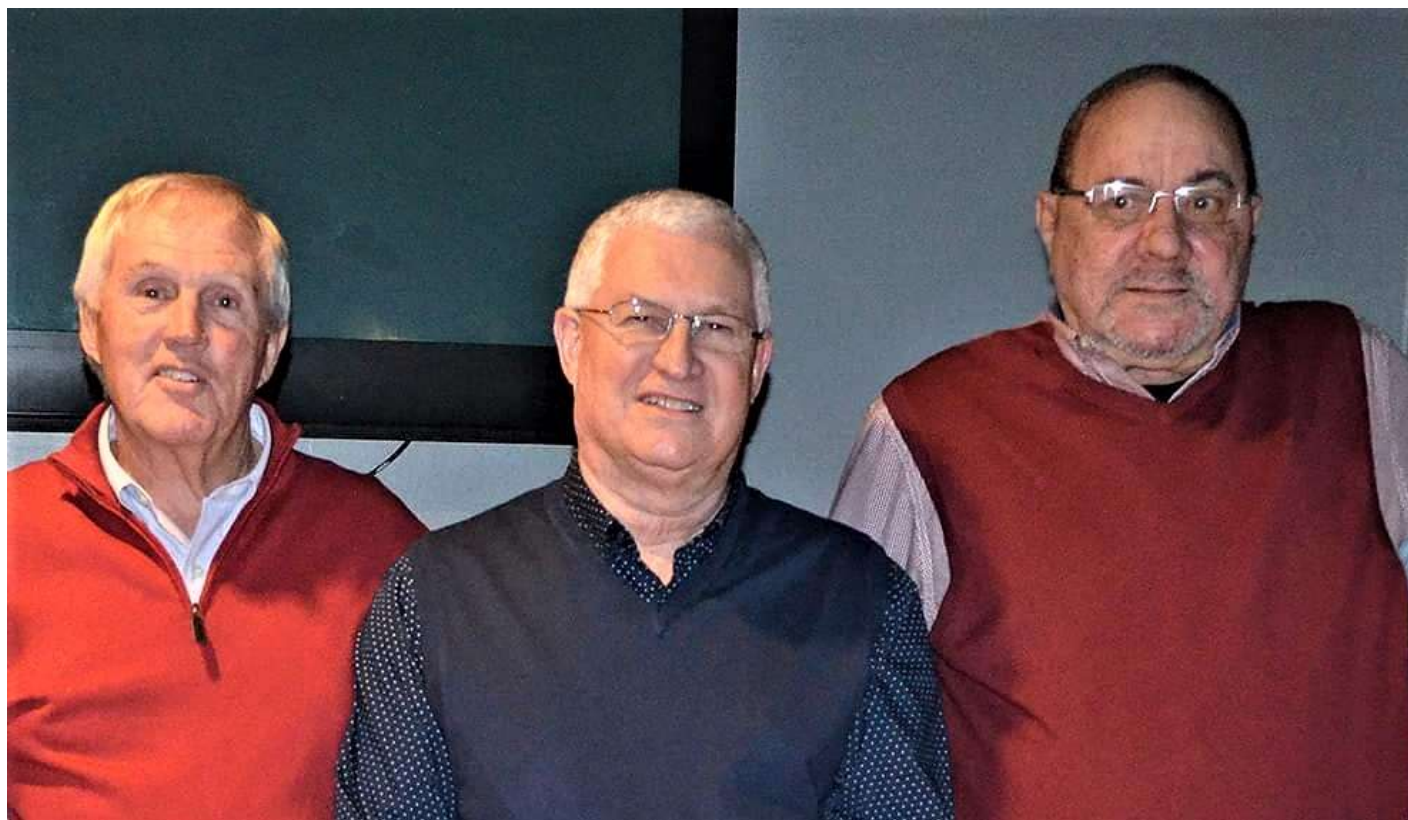

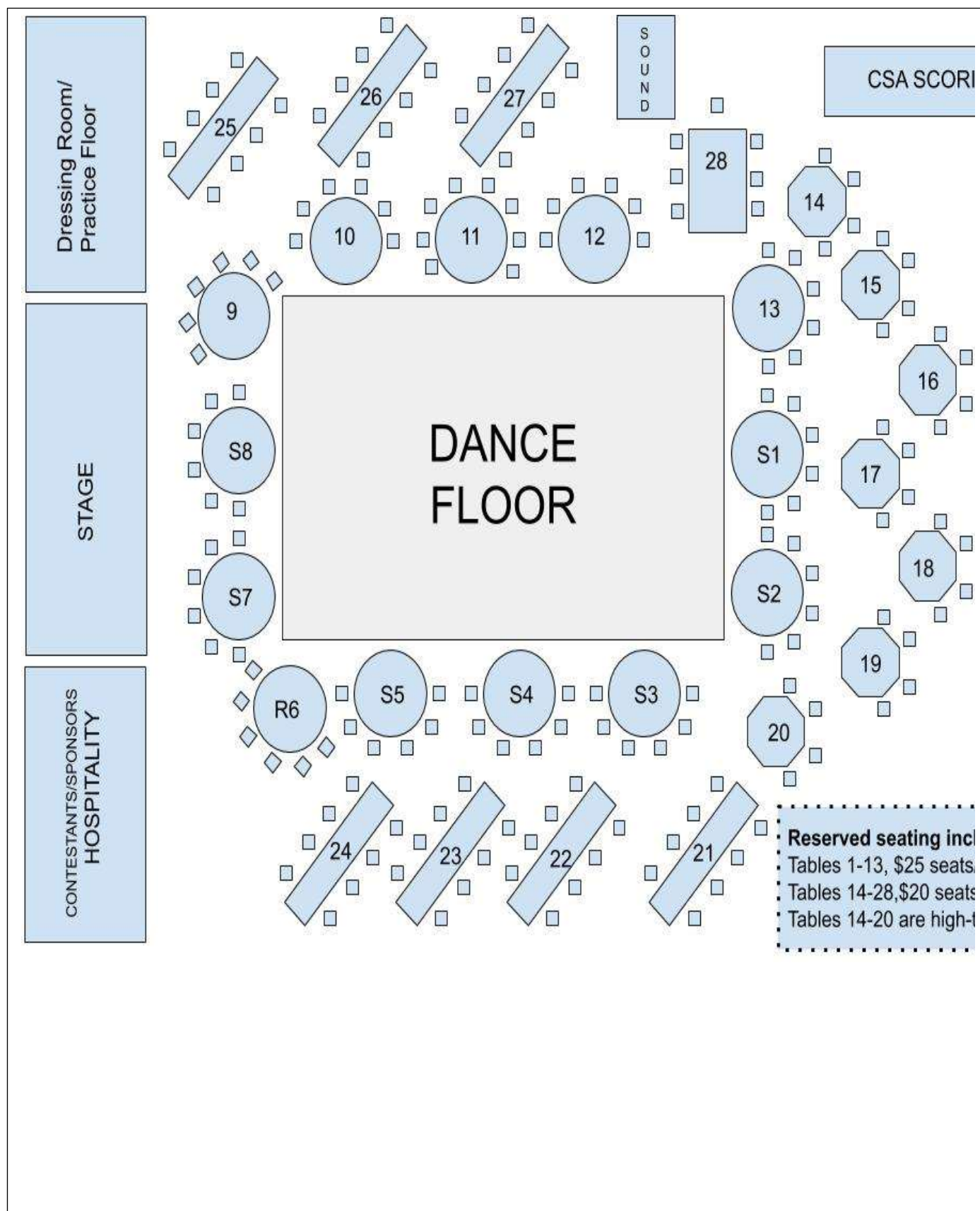

Lessons at Friar's Tavern on Dance Nights
