The Ellen Taylor Foundation for Junior Shaggers ("ETFJS") was founded in 2007 by Mrs. Ellen Taylor and incorporated as a SC 501-3(c) organization in 2008. The purpose of the ETFJS is to remove financial barriers that prevent those under 21 from learning and participating in the shag dance. Examples of this include providing free dance shoes, funding workshops, and providing meal, lodging, and gas vouchers for shag dance events such as Junior SOS at North Myrtle Beach.

Additional board members in attendance included: Gwyn Smith, Jim Coley, Dan and Brenda Ellington, Terry Gordon, Rick and Becky Wilson, Dede Ward, Skip Watkins and Karen Lewis, Alicia Pittman, Doug McLaughlin, Elaine Wilson, Steve and Jill Woodard, and Wayne Hembree.
- II. Approval of minutes from November 2020. Minutes were not available for approval.
- III. Approval of treasurer's report. Report was not available for approval.
- IV. Old Business included the recap of the 2020 Christmas.

President Blackwell said it was a great venue for the party and that the food selection and the service was very good. Hall of Fame DJ Billy Waldrep, as usual, did a great job of "spinning our favorite tunes." It was also noted that checking in attendees and temperature checks went smoothly. Sadly, only three or four attendees were masks for safety measures.

V. New Business

The "feeling" was that individuals who wish to help others with dance steps or line dancing should do so to the side of the dance floor as opposed to interfering with free dancing. (No motion or vote was made on this concern.).
