

It used to be that the person who currently had control of the pants selected the next victim. Presentation of the boogie pants has typically coincided with some type of celebration, achievement, etc. and they have always been worn as a badge of honor and truly one size does fit all.

The correct answer is 22.



Founded in 1994, Camp Courage creates an unforgettable recreational experience for children and teens with cancer or blood disorders from the Upstate of South Carolina, western North Carolina, and Northeast Georgia. Campers are free to play, laugh, explore, and grow in a normal developmentally appropriate way. 24 hour medical supervision is provided while children are at camp.

The Ellen Taylor Foundation for Junior

Shaggers is a non-profit charitable foundation dedicated to financial assistance in the education, preservation, and promotion of the Shag, the state dance of South Carolina. The purpose of the ETFJS is to remove financial barriers that prevent those under 21 from learning and participating in the shag dance.

Greenville Downtown Airport's Runway Park is free, open to the

public and has an educational amphitheater. With exercise and walking "Runways," as well as aviation themed playground equipment, the park meets the needs of our local school children who can no longer visit our larger airport due to security changes. It is believed that exposure to aviation may inspire some kids to careers in engineering, air traffic control, aircraft maintenance, in becoming a pilot or CNC machinist.
