

My New Year's resolution was to read more, so I turned on the subtitles on my TV.


I'm going to stay up late this New Year's Eve—not to ring in the New Year, but to make sure this one leaves.

Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> - Terri Medford was the Split-the-Pot winner for tonight, winning nearly \$100.





#### Carolina Shag Club Board Meeting - November 2, 2021

#### I. Call to Order

President Susan Blackwell called the final Zoom meeting of the year to order at 7:00 PM. Also in attendance were Rick Wilson, Gwyn Smith, Wayne Hembree, Doug McLaughlin, Jill Woodard, Brenda Ellington, Becky Wilson, Skip Watkins, Steve Woodard, Karen Lewis, and Phillip and Suzi Park.

#### **II.** Approval of Minutes

The minutes were Emailed to all board members prior to the meeting. President Blackwell called for all voting members to approve the minutes. It was so done.

#### III. Treasurer's Report

Wayne Hembree reported that the balance in the CSC account is \$20,614.90. One check was voided to Brenda Ellington, one check was made to Wayne Hembree, and one \$100 check was donated to the Hall of Fame Golf Tournament. Rick Wilson made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Steve Woodard seconded the motion, and the motion carried. A copy of the Treasurers Report is attached.

#### IV. Old Business

- Brenda Ellington (Social chairperson) and President Blackwell assured the board that the Christmas Party
  was planned. There were no last-minute concerns. They just wanted to encourage all members and guests
  to reserve tickets and tables (if they wish to) by the deadline, Friday, November 19<sup>th</sup>. Info for buying 2022

  Facebook.
- Rick Wilson (VP) reported that there were more issues with the Brass Monkey—floor buckling, bugs, offensive smells. He suggests we start looking for a new place to dance. This will be discussed in the new year.
