





CSC Board Meeting-February 8, 2022

I. Call to Order

President Steve Woodard called the February board meeting to order at 6:35 PM at the Hilton on Haywood Road. Also in attendance were Gwyn Smith, Wayne Hembree, Ann Allen, Donnie Cranfill, Mary Ellen Worrel, Phillip Park, Jill Woodard, Syble Hendricks, Brenda Ellington, Suzie Robinson-Park, Becky Wilson, Rick Wilson, Skip Watkins, Karen Lewis, Susan Kendrick, and Dan Ellington. Historian George Cummings will not be active for several weeks due to health problems.

II. Approval of Minutes

All board members were emailed a copy of the January minutes prior to the meeting. Wayne Hembree made the motion to approve the minutes. Phillip Park seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

III. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Wayne Hembree presented the board with copies of the Treasurer's Report including final numbers for year 2021 and income and expenses for January 2022. Phillip Park made a motion to accept the report. Gwyn Smith seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

IV. Old Business

The club's 2021 Christmas party has come and gone. The board felt that the party was very successful, as noted in the January minutes. Moving forward, Brenda Ellington and Suzie-Robinson Park, with the vote of the board, have secured the Embassy Suites for the 2022 Christmas party to be held on December 3rd. A \$1250 deposit was required to reserve the venue. (See new business for an alternate venue for the Christmas party.)

The February 9th, 2022 Valentine/Re-Up Memberships party was successful.

The St. Patrick's party will be held on March 16, 2022 at the Brass Monkey. (The venue for March 16th has been changed to Spare Time since the Feb. 8th board meeting.) Brenda Ellington and Suzie Robinson-Park are in charge of this event.

Dance lessons resumed on February 2, 2022. Steve and Jill Woodard are monitoring instructors for the basic step. Dennis Fleming and others are helping with line dancing.

V. New Business

Although the 2022 CSC Christmas party is scheduled for the Embassy Suites, an alternative facility was recommended.

*Wayne Hembree made the motion to open the discussion for the alternative facility. Phillip Park seconded the motion.

It was brought to the board's attention by Brenda Ellington that the Commerce Club could be an alternative venue. A strong deposit would be required. The date would have to change to December 2nd. We would need to guarantee 125 members would attend. The quote from the commerce was \$7,386.75. Parking would probably be a problem. Board members in attendance did not feel this would be a better venue.

The commerce club also quoted a just a spring party in April. That quote was \$1970.98. Board members also felt the quote was too high for the type of gathering the club was planning.

*Allen moved to close the discussion.

As mentioned in the January meeting, the storage facility for the shag club has not been cleaned out in a long time. President Steve Woodard suggested that interested board members meet on Saturday, February 12 at 1:00 PM at the storage facility on Pelham Rd. While there, items will be removed, thrown out, or possibly taken home to repair/decide whether to keep them or not. Steve set Saturday, March 5, to return to the storage site with items, shelving, and storage bins to reset the storage unit.

(A private matter of a shag club member was briefly addressed by a board member due to the issue being printed in social media. President Woodard asked the board not to discuss the matter going forward, since it did not involve our club.)

President-Elect Phillip Park and 2021 Vice-President Rick Wilson represented our club at the Winter ACSC on January 15, 2022 in North Myrtle Beach. All clubs were encouraged to participate in the SOS parade. Phillip provided all board members with an itemized summation of the items discussed.


