





"To be inducted in the Charleston Area Shaggers Hall of Fame is a tremendous honor for me since my whole life has been dedicated to Shag Dancing and teaching it to others. From the time I saw couples Shagging at Folly Beach in the 1950's to present day; dancing has been my passion and profession. I instruct college students and speak at conferences about therapeutic dance for patients with Parkinson's Disease and cancer."

"I am the author of 'Life Is A Dance', in which I stress the importance of dancing through every transition of my life. I have enjoyed dancing every week and promoting local Shag Clubs where I have served on the board. My mission is to preserve the heritage and art of Shag Dancing and Beach Music by teaching people of all ages."

"I encourage and welcome new students to visit and join Shag Clubs because it a place to have fun dancing and making new friends. I have also produced two videos demonstrating the basic and intermediate Shag steps so students can continue to practice and learn. Of the thousands of students I have taught over forty-five years, some have gone on to compete, others to teach, and many have become leaders in the local clubs. I continue to take lessons and am adaptable to all innovations of style. Thank you for considering me a worthy nominee of this special honor."

Camp Courage for 2022

The following is a message from Erika Turner, head of Camp Courage that she wanted to share with Carolina Shag Club.

Camp Courage Main and Teen Camp will run from Sunday, June 26th to Friday, July 1st. There is a different model for this year. Camp Courage will be a hybrid camp experience that includes day camp and virtual experiences for campers. Each camper will have the opportunity to attend camp for one day out of the camp week and on the remaining days, can participate virtually from home. If a camper is unable to attend camp in person for any reason, they are welcome to participate in the virtual program portion. Their goal is for this year is to serve as a transition to being back at camp, in-person!




