






Save the Ta-Ta's Party on October 4th

- II. III. After approval of the minutes, the treasure's report was presented. For the circumstances, the club is continuing to break even with t-shirts, 50/50, DJ expenses, and party costs.
- IV. Old Business- Thus far \$610 was raised at the Save the TATA Party with the expectations of more to be turned in. Terri and Brenda were commended for decorations.
