

## Greenville Area Shaggers Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony-August 17, 2022

The Greenville Area Shaggers Hall of Fame (GASHOF) held the 2020 induction event at Spare Time on Wednesday, August 17 from 6:00-7:00 pm.

The GASHOF was founded in 2014 as a means of honoring those that have made significant contributions to the Shag lifestyle within a 60-mile radius of Greenville. Why the 60 miles?

The Carolina Shag Club, located in Greenville, was one of the first shag clubs in the state and the only shag club in northwest SC and southwestern NC in those days. People from Spartanburg, Greenwood, Easley, Anderson, Hendersonville, Asheville and other locations, would travel to Greenville for dancing and get-togethers. Many people from all those areas that are deserving of recognition for their contributions.

When founded, people from the area that were members of the National Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame (now home in Ocean Drive, but originally founded in Greenville), The Beach and Shag club DJ Hall of Fame or a Shag Icon, were installed as the original members of the GASHOF. Although there is a board for the GASHOF, the board does NOT select people for induction.

Every year, the new members of the GASHOF are asked to nominate two deserving people to be added to the "list," and it can be anyone of their choosing. All nominees are added to the "list" then. Next all current members that have paid their dues Have the opportunity to vote for four people to be inducted into the GASHOF each year. The four with the highest vote counts are the "inductees" for the current year.

- Rusty Cabaniss Rusty has been a member of CSC and R&B Shag Club in Spartanburg, SC for many years. He is a fun dancer, a lover of the music and participates in many dances in the various events held by local shag clubs.


