You do not have to have a partner to learn how to shag!

Classes are 4-week sessions starting the first Wednesday of each month

Beginner class: 6:00 - 6:40

Learn the basic step, female turn, male turn and shag start

Beginner II class: 6:40 - 7:15 (immediately following Beginner class) Learn classic Carolina Shag steps including the bellyroll, hip step, pivot, trail, basic variations, and many more

Advanced class: 6:40 - 7:15 Held only on the 4th Wednesday of each month. Learn advanced footwork, turns and mirror steps.

Cost: \$30 per person for the 4 week session or \$10 per person per session in Beginner II class only and Advanced class

You do not have to pre-register. Just come the first Wednesday of the month and we will register you then.

CAROLINA SHAG CLUB BOARD MEETING MINUTES – JUNE 13, 2023 6:30 pm

I. Call to order

<u>President Phillip Park</u> called the meeting to order. II. Approval of Minutes

Dede Ward corrected minutes that said she would like someone to replace her doing the Web Page. Corrected minutes were approved.

III. Treasurer's Report

<u>Wayne Hembree</u> reported we now have \$31,000 in bank and are more financially sound than we have been for years.

IV. Old Business

GOLF TOURNAMENT - <u>Suzie Robinson-Park</u> stated we will have the Golf Tournament at Saluda Valley Golf Course and will have further information at a later meeting.

SHAG LESSONS — Phillip Park reported that Amy Allgood, with Spare Time Management, wasn't in agreement with Shag Teachers charging for shag lessons. He said we could still have lessons if the charge is \$5.00 per person and the money charged goes to the club. Several people questioned why that should matter to Spare Time and that CSC had, in the past, always had teachers that charged for them. It was good for the club and brought more people to the venue. Danny Scott said he and Susan Welch would like to teach there, but feel they should be able to charge, as most teachers do that have their experience. Susan Welch was on the phone and said she had talked to Amy and explained that Greensboro Spare Time allowed it in Greensboro and this Spare Time allows Swing lessons to charge for their lessons. She explained the benefits to Spare Time and Carolina Shag Club and Amy told her she would talk to the Corporate Office and get back to her. Ann Allen made a motion to table this until Susan hears back from Spare Time. Steve Woodard seconded the

motion. Steve Woodard made a motion to wait for the response from Spare Time, then go forward, voting via e-mail, if necessary. Wayne Hembree seconded the motion. All approved. Motion passed.

SUNDAY DANCING – Phillip Park reported dates are scheduled for June 25, July 30, August 20, and September 10.

FUN MONDAY TICKETS – 10 tickets were given to board members that will be responsible for selling them.

Gail Pang is helping, but Ann still needs more help for both Friday and Saturday nights.

WAYS AND MEANS/FUNDRAISER 50/50 - No one to take Lynn Hart's place yet.

<u>SOCIAL</u> – <u>Judy and Ernie West</u> – Need to purchase some things for July 4th decorations. Ann Allen made a motion for \$50 for decorations. Steve Woodard seconded. Motion passed.

LOCAL CHARITIES – **Dianne Hembree** was absent.

WEB PAGE - Dede Ward - Nothing new.
